**Topic: Conclusions from the Book of Esther**

**Bible Text: Esther Chapters 1 to 10**

**Brief Summary of the book of Esther:** This book can be divided into three main sections:

**Chapters: 1:1-2:18-** King Ahasuerus's sovereignty and Esther replaces Vashti

**Chapters: 2:19-7:10** – Mordecai overcomes Haman

**Chapters: 8:1-40:3-** Israel survives Haman's attempt to destroy them.

The Book of Esther shows the choice we make between seeing the hand of God in our circumstances in life and seeing things as mere coincidence. God is the sovereign ruler of the universe and we can be assured that His plans will not be moved by the actions of mere evil men. His providential care for his people, both individuals, and the nations are evident throughout.

**Lessons from the Book of Esther**

1. The decree of a King is binding- Ecc.8:4
2. Pride is a trap and goes before a fall, humility is the key- Esther 1:10-12, 19-22, Prov. 11:2, James 4:6  
\*Beauty or our gifts should not make us boastful
3. Be wise and adhere to reasonable (wise) instructions- Esther 2:10
4. God has a plan for your life and destiny- Esther 4:14, Prov. 16:9  
\*You are given divine moments to alter your circumstances- believe in your hidden power-Ester4  
\* You have a choice and must decide  
\*The obstacle most of the time is the way
5. Esther was courageous- you must stand with courage- Esther 4:16, Eph.6:10  
\* Live for something greater than yourself
6. Prayer and fasting brings clarity and hope for our deliverance- Esther 4
7. A selfless outlook on life- loving others is the most beautiful thing we can do.  
\* We can make an impact for generations
8. Everything, everybody, and every circumstance can bring God's divine purpose.
9. Divine favor makes the difference- Esther 2:17
10. A positive outlook on life is mandatory for an achiever- "If I perish, I perish mindset".  
\* A life of dogmatic and resilient faith
11. God uses ordinary people to do extraordinary things.
12. There is a mentor, destiny helper, up-lifter, and promoter your way. The Past does not dictate our future
13. The forgotten can be remembered- Esther 2:21-23, 6, Psalm 126
14. God can turn the devil's plan on its head- Esther7, Prov. 26:27

The book of Esther is a book of God's usual grace, it is a story relatable by everyone. Despite the shortcomings in life, Esther was able to find greater scope and save a nation by channeling her courage. It is important to remember that we all can create greatness and achieve the goals placed in our lives by God.
