**Topic: HOLY SPIRIT DIVINE**

**Text: 1 Cor. 2:9-16, Matt. 28:19-20, 2 Cor. 13:14, Rom. 8:14-17**

**Introduction**

The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Triune God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. These three Personalities are distinct in operation and dispensations. The first dispensation is the dispensation of the Father: Adam to John the Baptist. The second dispensation is that of the Son: Matthew to John while the dispensation of the Spirit is from Acts till date. The Holy Spirit is equal with the Father and the Son in deity and personality. Matt. 28:19-20

**Some of His Attributes**

Never refer to the Holy Spirit as “IT”. He is a Person and not a force or object. Because you cannot see Him with your physical eyes does not mean He does not exist. Some attributes are:

**1. His Personality**

- He has a mind – 1 Cor. 2:10-11. No one can know the thoughts of God without having mind. Rom. 8:27
- He has emotions. Eph. 4:30. You can't grieve a force; you can only grieve persons.
- He has a will. 1 Cor. 12:11. He chooses who to distributes gifts and by what measure.
- He is called Holy. Holiness attaches to His character and nature.

**2. His Actions**

- He teaches. John 14:26
- He bears witness of Jesus and bears witness of us. John 15:26 and Rom. 8:14-17
- He leads and guides. Rom. 8:14
- He helps our infirmities by interceding for us. Rom. 8:26
- He sends out missionaries for the great work of harvesting souls. Acts 13:4

**3. His Mistreatment**

- He can be lied to. Acts 5:3. Can you lie to electricity or a piece of wood?
- He can be resisted. Acts 7:51
- He can be insulted. Heb. 10:29
- He can be blasphemed. Matt. 12:31 – Remember this cannot be forgiven.

**4. His Deity**

- Omniscience. 1 Cor. 2:10 – The Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.
- Omnipotence. Zech. 4:6 – But by my Spirit. Jer. 32:27 – Is anything too hard for Me.
- Omnipresence. Psalms 139:7-10. David said, “Where can I go from your presence?”

**Conclusion** – The Holy Spirit must be worshipped as God because His works include creation, regeneration, sanctification, conviction of sin, righteousness and judgment, raising the dead and putting a seal upon the believers in readiness for the coming eternal kingdom. PRAISE the Holy Spirit.
