TOPIC: Why Jesus came into the World

Text: Matt. 1:21, Rom. 5:12-21, 1 Tim. 2:5

Introduction:

God existed in eternity past as ONE God but Three Persons. Jesus Christ is the Second Person of Trinity who came for the project of salvation. Every religion ended at “One God” but there exists the progressive revelations of God as the Triune God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. 1 John 5:7

The Garden of Eden is where it started – Gen. 2:15-18

1. God created Adam as a **spirit** (can't die) and as a **freewill** being (not a robot).
2. God gave Adam a **command** not to eat the fruit of the tree of knowledge.

The Immutability of God – Heb. 6:18

God's **nature** cannot change – Holiness and God's **word** cannot change – Truth. For God to be a TRUE and HOLY God, He must uphold His Word till the very end. In Vs. 17, He revealed the consequence of sin ever before it happened.

Sin and Death were Introduced – Rom. 5:12

1. Adam disobeyed God's commandment -
2. As a result of Adam's disobedience, sin was introduced into the world -
3. The result of sin is death – Physical, spiritual and eternal death. Rom. 6:23
4. Because God is holy and through His Word, He cannot punish a sinless man and He cannot spare a sinful man. Job 8:20
5. Because God loved man so much, He decided to come and die for the sin of man and for the mess created by his disobedience.

So, why did Jesus come?

1. It was God's will to save us. There was no other way or option. John 3:14, Num. 21:1-9
2. God had to uphold the punishment because He is not a liar. Num. 23:19
3. Offering forgiveness without enforcing punishment would have gone against God's nature and His Word. John 11:49-50
4. To remain just, the penalty had to be paid – Rom. 3:23. Only Jesus had the moral justification to die because He did not sin.
5. Jesus had to become the “Only Acceptable Substitute” for all of us. Heb. 9

How to respond to this Grace?

Love Him and have faith in the substitution that God provided for us. Heb. 10:29

Conclusion - Because God cannot overlook sin, you either bear the punishment yourself and if you do bear it, you go to HELL; or rely on God's appointed substitute (Jesus) by surrendering your life totally to Him and then you have eternal life.
