# Three Things people run after in the world

## **WINE**

# Who is a Champion?



A Champion is someone who has defeated all rivals to take first place in a competition, contest, or sport, embodying supreme skill and superiority.

A Champion (Latin Campio) is the victor in a challenge, contest or competition.

A Champion is someone who has overcome hurdles, systems, contests, competitions, examinations, battles and tests to become winner.

A Champion is someone who can see what others don't see; hear what others don't hear and understand what others don't understand.

Jesus Christ is the Greatest and the Undisputed Champion of all time because He has never lost any Battle.

# Face of a MAN

Pro. 23:7  
As a Man thinks, so is he.

## Reasoning – Ability to think.

- You are as progressive as your mind. *Work on your mind*
- Decision making starts here.  
*Train your Mind not to procrastinate*
- The Mind is unlimited in capacity.  
*There's nothing the mind wants to do that it will not do*

# Face of a LION

Pro. 28:1  
But the righteous are  
bold as a lion.

- **Boldness.** Is an Aspect of Righteousness. Don't panic
- **Risk-taking.** A lion will take all the risks to kill its prey
- **Focus.** Be intentional in your pursuit
- **Diet.** Be open to something fresh daily

1 Tim 5:18  
Don't muzzle the Ox.

- **Endurance and Tenacity.**
- Don't give up.
- Rome was not built in a day.
- Be disciplined
- Quitters don't win and winners don't quit
- Wait on the Lord. Some results take time to manifest

- **Vision, Strength and Height.**

# Thoughts Provoking Questions

- What do you have in your **hand**? Job, cert, computer.

- What skills do you have? Education, training, knowledge.

# Price of Championship

1. **Spirituality.** There are two types of spiritual power: Divine and Devilish.
2. **Identifying** your Calling. Eg. Bill Gates - Computers
3. Quest for **Knowledge.**
4. **Skills** Acquisition and Resource Management.
5. **Apprenticeship.** You will never meet a pilot, doctor, professor who trained himself. Learn to serve first.
6. **Trial Balance** or Terrain Testing.
7. **Start up.** Every champion must learn to start.
